Full disclosure: I love Bardolino so much that I am biased before I even start this tasting note. It's a street-party trampoline pile-on of sour cherries, ripe strawberries, liquorice allsorts, lemon verbena, lovage, gravel and Sichuan pepper. The tannins are camp, arch, teasing, ingenuous, tightly clad in deep-pink pants. To call this wine quaffable is to do its authenticity, energy, integrity and beautiful balance an injustice. But it's seriously hard not to glug this wine! (TC)
