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Full bottle 1,373 g. Turbiana.

This smells and tastes like warm sunlight on freshly mown, stardust-daisy-speckled green lawn with a handful of pebble dust and pepper-gritted sea-salt flakes. It tastes like borage leaves and a lick of seaglass and tempura sorrel leaves and tiny clippings of dill. I can feel a tiny electric buzz on my tongue, because this is, really, a baby wine. But it's a wine that makes me thirsty, and it's a wine that coaxes me to lean into it because it's got things to whisper in my ear about blue-green lakes and stones and winds that come down cold from the mountains and I can hear why this wine is asymmetrical in my mouth: leaning to the left with its glacial minerality, salty etch, tetchy lines; curling to the right with ripe fruit and convex conversation. I like the conversation. (TC)
